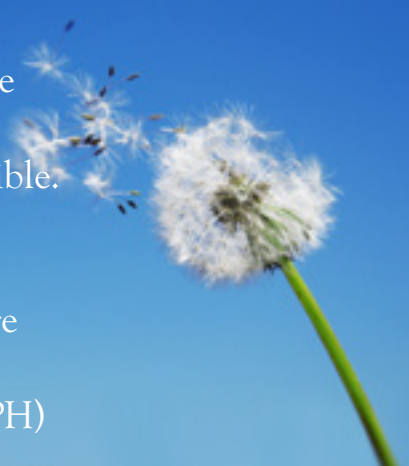
Heavenly Father,
